## Cleve Archers

Dear Sir/Madam,

Thank you for your enquiry about beginners' lessons with Cleve Archers. Cleve Archers was founded in 1960 to practice and promote the sport of Archery in accordance with the rules of the governing body for the sport, **The Grand National Archery Society (GNAS)**. The club is also affiliated to the regional organisation, **The Grand Western Archery Society (GWAS)**. Cleve Archers is wholly run by volunteers and is one of the largest clubs in the county (Gloucestershire Archery Society).

Our 6 week outdoor **junior beginners' lessons** will run every Saturday **from 27 March 2010** at 10.00am – 11.30am at a cost of £50 for juniors. The lessons will be held at 'Up Yonder', Bury Hill, Moored, Hambrook, Bristol. They will be fully supervised by our coaches and all equipment will be provided (you will only need to bring yourself and a soft drink). It is advisable to wear suitable footwear (walking boots, trainers etc) and a long sleeved close fitting top.

We strongly suggest that beginners **do not buy any equipment** until completion of the course. Archery equipment is expensive and highly individual. Our coaches will be able to advise you on the best equipment to buy.

At the end of the course you may choose to join the Club as a full member, subject to paying the full member subscription and affiliation fees. The current (2008/9) membership fees are:

**Notes:**

- Parents are to remain with their juniors throughout the lessons unless permission has been received from the Course leader/Senior Coach.
- As part of the coaching it may be necessary for some minor contact between the student and coach.
- It is the responsibility of the student to inform the club of any medical conditions which might affect them during archery sessions
- The use of video/photography equipment by students is permitted but must be recorded in the clubs logbook.
- Only club owned equipment will be used during lessons; the use of privately owned equipment is not permitted.
- Outdoor lessons - Although limited seating is available, it is recommended that students bring their own seating and refreshments.
- Outdoor lessons - As a general rule lessons are not affected by poor weather and will only be cancelled in cases of severe weather.
- We are planning on introducing a refreshments facility as part of the lessons; tea/coffee will be available at the cost of 50p per person, per lesson but cannot be guaranteed.

**Refund policy:**

- If an applicant wishes to cancel their place on the course a full refund will only be provided if a replacement applicant can be found before the course commences
- Once a course has started no refunds or credit will be granted unless lessons are cancelled by the course organisers.

### ***Directions from M32 Junction 1***

***Following the signs for Yate go through the Hambrook traffic lights and at the Bromley Heath roundabout turn left. Continue on the dual carriage way to the next roundabout and turn left. Take the first turning left into Cuckoo Lane (signposted Cottage Kennels). Follow this road taking the first turning left into Bury Hill. Carry on up the hill round the S bends passing open fields to either side for approx 200 yds. After the next bend turn right into a private lane leading to Up Yonder, a triangle warning sign is opposite the entrance (If you have reached the house on the left before turning into the lane you have gone too far!!) Carry on down through the lane keeping the house to your right you will reach the car park.***
