## Directions from M32 Junction 1

**Following the signs for Yate on the A4174 go through the Hambrook traffic lights and at the Bromley Heath roundabout turn left.**

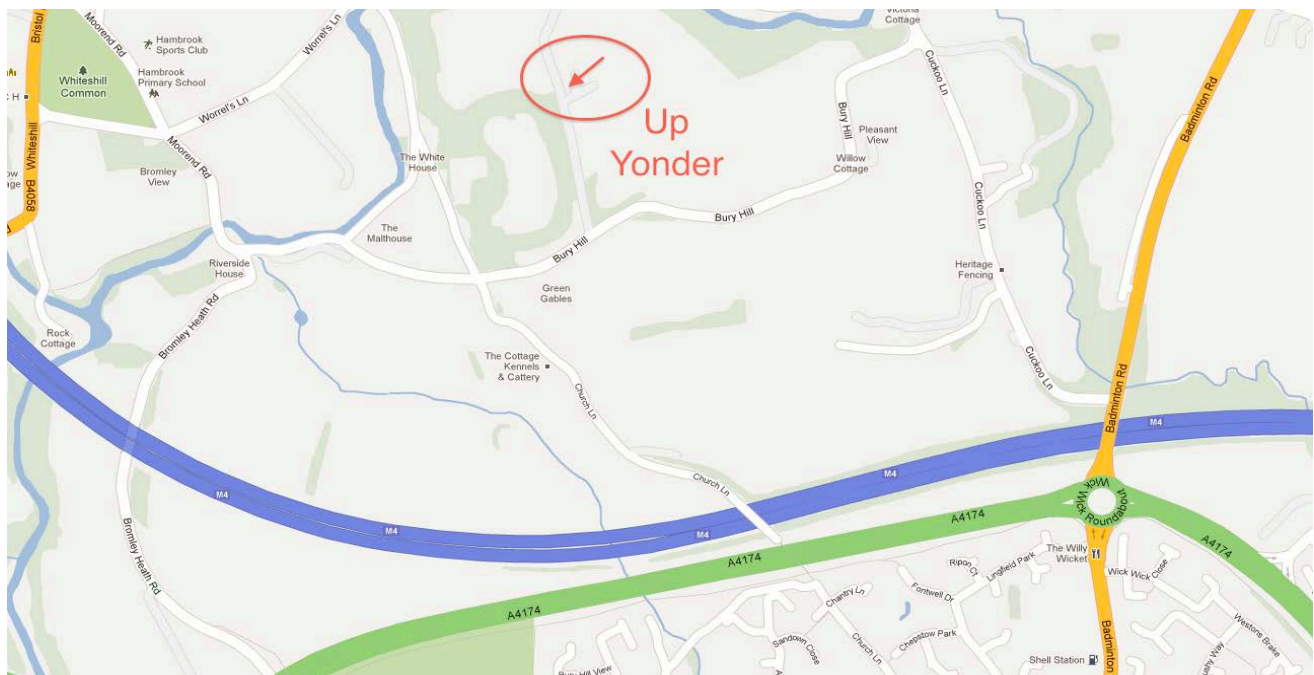
**Continue on the A4174 dual carriageway to the next roundabout (Wick Roundabout) and turn left.**

**Almost immediately take the first turning left into Cuckoo Lane (signposted Cottage Kennels).**

**Follow this road taking the first turning left into Bury Hill. Carry on up the hill round the sharp "S" bends, then passing a house and then open fields to either side for approx 200 yards.**

**After the next bend turn right into a private lane leading to Up Yonder, stone wall entrance with a horse stable and gate opposite entrance (if you have reached the house on the left before turning into the lane you have gone too far!!)**

**Carry on down the lane keeping the pink house to your right, you will reach a gate with a target on that you need to go through (please close the gate behind you), drive on through the next gate and the car park is there in front of you by the large wooden shelter.**
