

Directions to Cleve Archers

We are located on a farm/livery called “Up Yonder”.

Address: Bury Hill, Moorend, Hambrook, Bristol, BS16 1SS.

Sat Navs: The postcode, BS16 1SS, is reasonably accurate. Using it on a Tom Tom should get you more or less exactly to the entrance on Bury Hill. Using Google Maps it will get you to within about 75 yards of the entrance.

Please note the following, especially if you have been to Cleve Archers before.

The local council has left in place some road closures that were installed when major road works were undertaken on the local ring-road (A4174). These closures may well affect the route that you might have taken to Up Yonder in the past, or the route that any SatNav devices you have think is the quickest route. Please do cross-reference the information below with any routes you or your SatNavs choose.

On the maps below, there are 3 road closures marked with ‘No Entry’ symbols. These are located on Cuckoo Lane, Bury Hill and [the old] Bromley Heath Road. These are likely to affect your route if you are approaching from the south (through suburbs such as Frenchay, Downend and Emersons Green area) or from the east on the A4174 ring-road. If you approach from the north through Coalpit Heath, the west via the A4174 ring-road or using the M4 and M32 motorways your preferred route to Up Yonder may be affected, although there are alternatives that are just as easy. If you approach through Winterbourne, your route should be unaffected.

Here are some suggested routes. Provided you follow these, you can ignore any ‘Road Ahead Closed’ signs that you encounter.

Approach from	Suggested route
<i>Frenchay/Downend</i>	Get onto the A4174 ring-road and head in the direction of the Hambrook Lights. At the Hambrook Lights head north on the B4058 Bristol Road. Then follow the directions below as if you had arrived via the M4/M32.
<i>West on A4174 ring-road</i>	Stay on the A4174 ring-road until the Hambrook Lights, then following the directions below as if you had arrived via the M4/M32.
<i>M4 and M32 motorways</i>	From M4, get onto the M32 (heading into Bristol) and then get off M32 at the first junction (J1). Turn left at the bottom of the slip road (roundabout) onto A4174 ring road. At the first set of traffic lights you come to (Hambrook) turn left (onto B4058 Bristol Road). Follow this road for about $\frac{3}{4}$ mile (it will bend sharply right after 0.3 miles, then pass under the M4, then bend sharp left (with pub on your right) and uphill. You will then need to take the first road on your right (Worrell’s Lane) – this is just as the road reaches the brow of hill. Follow Worrell’s Lane for 200 yards (with sports field on your left and open space on the right) to a crossroads where you need to turn right into Moorend Road. Ignore any signs you see which say ‘Road Closed’. Follow this road downhill (steep and narrow), over a short and very narrow bridge and around a very narrow and tight bend turning to the left. You are now in the hamlet of Moorend. Stay left and follow Moorend Road (stream on your left). Ignore two roads on your left (the second of which you will pass as the road has just started to go steeply

	uphill – this is now Bury Hill). As you get to the top of the steep bit, the road bends to the left and after about 100 yards you will get to the entrance to Up Yonder on your left.
<p><i>South via Emersons Green or East on A4174 ring-road or North through Coalpit Heath.</i></p>	<p>If coming from South or East, get onto the A432 (Badminton Road) and drive north over the M4 for about 400 metres until you get to Down Road on your left. You cannot use Cuckoo Lane anymore.</p> <p>If coming from the North, stay on the A432 until you get to Down Road (on your right).</p> <p>Turn into Down Road. You now need to follow Down Road through Winterbourne Down for about 1½ miles (mostly uphill, narrow in places, past church on your left when the road bends sharply right and uphill) until you encounter Mill Road on the left-hand side which you need to turn into. This is a VERY sharp turn, almost doubling-back on yourself and downhill at the same time. Follow Mill Road downhill for 0.4 miles where it opens out and sweeps around to the right. You need to indicate left as you want to go straight ahead and not follow the road around to the right. The 'road' you want will almost look like a gap in the trees and there will very probably be some 'Road Closed' signs which you can ignore. It is single track so go slowly. You will quickly go over a stream. Keep ahead for 0.2 miles until the road forks and you will want to fork off to left (it is uphill and very narrow). Follow this narrow lane for another 0.2 miles until you come to a small crossroads. You will want to turn left here (steeply uphill) onto Bury Hill. Again, ignore the 'Road Closed' signs. Follow Bury Hill for about 100 yards you will get to the entrance to Up Yonder on your left</p>
<p><i>North through Winterbourne</i></p>	<p>Follow the B4058 (Bristol Road) south through Winterbourne and fork left onto Dragon Road. After 0.4 miles fork (turn) right onto Mill Road and follow directions from Mill Road as given above for those coming from the East.</p>

If your approach is not covered above please contact the club.

Entrance to Up Yonder: Once you have arrived at the entrance to Up Yonder, follow the 'road' into the farm (about 100 yards) until you come to a large wooden gate. The gate will have a number of signs on it relating to it being a livery yard and hopefully still the odd picture of an archery target ! Open the gate, go through it and please shut the gate after you. At this point you are only 70 yards from our field.

To find the field, go straight ahead down the grit-track and keep straight ahead as you pass buildings on your right. Don't turn right or park to the right after the buildings as that is the parking for the livery. You will soon see our field and brown club hut/container on your right.
